2023 Flu Shots

Now is the time to start thinking about when, how and where you'll get immunized against the flu this year.



Flu season typically peaks between December and February, but you should plan on getting your flu shot early to protect yourself and those around you.

It is simple to get a flu shot at no cost from an in-network pharmacy or doctor's office!

Although we are offering onsite flu shots at various locations for City employees (see next page), it's important to remember that you can get a flu shot at <u>no cost</u> by visiting your Kaiser Permanente of Washington or Regence BlueShield in-network doctor's offices and/or pharmacies.

Kaiser Permanente Members

- ◆ Appointments: No cost flu shots are available at Kaiser Permanente by <u>appointment only</u>. You can make an appointment through your online Kaiser Permanente account, via the Mobile App, or by calling 1-800-352-3610.
- ▼ Contracted pharmacies: Members can get their flu shot at a <u>contracted pharmacy</u>. No appointment is needed. Contracted pharmacies will bill Kaiser Permanente directly.
- ▶ Non-contracted pharmacies: Flu shots can be obtained by non-contracted pharmacies. If the pharmacy does not bill Kaiser Permanente Washington, then the member will need to pay for the vaccine/administration and submit a claim to Kaiser Permanente for reimbursement.

Regence BlueShield Members

- ▼ Appointments: Look for an in-network provider who offers a flu shot through "Find a Doctor". Select the category Doctors by specialty and search for "flu shot." You can also visit the immunization section of the benefit booklet or call their customer service at 1-855-877-0047.
- ▶ In-network pharmacies: No appointment is necessary when you visit an in-network pharmacy, which includes Walgreens, Rite Aid, Safeway, Fred Meyer, Costco and more.

Need medical care? If you or an eligible family member do get sick and need medical care, you are encouraged to review the different options available through <u>Kaiser Permanente</u> and <u>Regence</u> <u>BlueShield</u> (e.g., virtual, at your doctor's office/facility, or even on-call care at your home).
